Option 2: Sign Up In-Person

Visit one of the sign-up sites listed on the reverse side of this flyer. You will receive an Access Card at the time of sign up. Signing up in-person only takes 5 minutes.

You may sign up for a DA BUX Access Card if you are an active SNAP-EBT cardholder and you do not currently have an Access Card or your Access Card was lost or stolen. A lost or stolen DA BUX Access Card does not need to be reported because it is not linked to individual users or personal identifying information. All sign-up information provided will only be used internally by DA BUX program staff for evaluation purposes.
